The New York Council of Administrators of Special Education (NYCASE) is excited to solicit original works created by students with disabilities, for a gallery display at our Summer Conference: **Growing Minds ~ Ours, Yours and Theirs**. (See details www.nycase.org).

NYCASE is the NY division of CASE/CEC (Council of Special Education Administrators/Council for Exceptional Children). We are a statewide advocacy/professional development association representing professionals who provide leadership to and administer services for students with disabilities. During this year's conference, we hope to feature the talent many of our students have in the arts. We seek a cross-representation of works including paintings, drawings, mixed media, sculpture, ceramics, photography, jewelry, pottery and textile arts.

We require that either a conference attendee or a school district representative deliver the work(s) to and pick them up from the Gideon Putnam Hotel & Resort. Neither NYCASE nor the Gideon Putnam Hotel & Resort will be responsible for any items submitted, but NYCASE will make every effort to set up and monitor a secure display. We will use draped tabletops and/or display boards. Hanging art must be matted or mounted (for stability) with overall dimensions no larger than 14"x20". Tabletop pieces must not exceed 5lbs. or 1-square foot. **Works must be removed from the hotel by Wednesday, July 19, 2017 no later than 2:00 PM.**
